From the Heart

In the course of His ministry, Jesus healed a man possessed by a demon (Matthew 12:22). This caused the people to react with amazement, but the Pharisees reacted by saying that Jesus cast out demons by Beelzebub, the prince of the demons (12:23-24). Jesus answered their accusation, then turned it around to them. In verse thirtythree, Jesus said, "Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit."

Jesus' statement rings true for us. People will know us by our fruits, and they will know us by the things that we say. Jesus said that evil people speak evil things because they speak from the heart. Similarly, good people speak good things because they speak from the heart. I often hear people say, "Well I don't want to judge." People do not like to judge, but without making some kind of judgment, how can we truly know someone by their fruits like Jesus said? Jesus said that we can see the evil fruits of another by the things that they say.

What does this mean? Well, first it means that we should take care to guard what we say. We should do this not only because others will see our true selves through our words, but also because we will give account of every idle word that we speak (12:26). Second, it means that we should make sure that we have pure hearts, because if we do not, then it will come out by how we speak. If we notice ourselves saying shameful things, that means we should look inward and make changes.
