#### The Next Generation

As Christians, we have a responsibility to get to Heaven. We love God, and we love our neighbors (Matthew 22:37-40). When we progress through life, we hopefully try to better ourselves continually, never remaining content with staying in the same place spiritually. Self-improvement should always have a huge part of our spiritual focus. But we have responsibility to more than just ourselves. Paul told his protégé, "And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also "2 Timothy 2:2." Paul also instructed Titus that aged women should teach younger women (Titus 2:3-4).

We all have a duty to the next generation. Parents must bring up their children "in the nurture and admonition of the Lord" (Ephesians 6:4). God told parents of old to teach their children about His words (Deuteronomy 6:6-7), to incorporate spiritual things in all areas of daily life. But the obligation toward the new generation rests on more than just parents. All Christians must exhort one another (Hebrews 10:25), and edify one another (1 Thessalonians 5:11). Paul told Timothy: "Let no man despise thy youth; but be thou an example of the believers, in word, in conversation, in charity, in spirit, in faith, in purity" (1 Timothy 4:12), but how could Timothy become that example for others without someone older, like Paul, teaching and encouraging him, serving as his example?




"Getting Acquainted with Grief" Sunday, August 28th
