Fearless

We live in an uncertain world, a place where we need to look both ways when we cross the street, or lock our doors at night so nothing will hap- pen to us. However, even with all of the precautions we might take, things still can go wrong. If we think too much about it, it can cause us to become afraid of our own shadow. Yet living in fear does not help us, and we certainly cannot live our best lives when we cow- er in the dark. God tells us that we do not need to fear anything on this earth. The psalmist said it this way: "The Lord is on my side; I will not fear: what can man do unto me?" (Psalms 118:6). Those who trust in God have Him on their side, and anyone on God's side wins.

But we must ask, does this mean that nothing bad will ever happen to us? To answer that question, we have to con-sider closely what the psalmist actually said, so we can understand what he did not say as well. He asked what man could do to him. He did not say that man could do nothing to him. People have the power to hurt us, and they always will. But that hurt only extends to our earthly living. Jesus told us that we do not need to fear even those who have the power to kill us (Luke 12:4). Why? Man can do no further harm, and because we have a great reward in heaven (Matthew 5:11–12), which nobody can take away.
