Communication from Our Great God

God spoke with mankind. If you think about that for a minute, you would realize the magnificence of such communication. God interacted with us in spite of the tremendous difference between us. Isaiah says, "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the LORD. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts" (Isaiah 55:8-9). Consider the thought gap between man and God. We humans probably have an intelligence closer to the ants than we do to God. Yet we do not try to communicate with the ants.

God chose to talk to us though. The Psalmist asked the question, "What is man that thou art mindful of him?" (Psalm 8:4). Sure we cannot approach the sheer glory of the Lord, but He created us, and takes an interest in us. Psalm 90 discusses the difference between God and man. God has existed form everlasting to everlasting (Psalm 90:2), and humans live around seventy years (Psalm 90:10). But ultimately, the psalmist prayed to God to "Let thy work appear unto thy servants, and thy glory unto their children (90:16). Even with the disparity between God's eternal glory and man's limited nature, God cares for us because He made us (Acts 17:27-28). As His offspring, we should recognize His greatness, and give thanks for all the love that He has given to us.
