Blessing

In the beatitudes, for example (Matthew 5:3-12), Jesus listed many different things that cause people to experience blessing, even some things that do not seem positive at first. Humility, mourning, meekness, a hunger for God's word, mercy, purity in heart, peacemaking, even persecution bring blessing, happiness, to the ones who possess these traits. If we want God to bless us, should we hope for a blessing, pray for a blessing, wait for a blessing to fall into our laps?

We need to seek blessings by the way we live our lives. Obviously, we all fall victim to a certain amount of circumstance. However, that does not mean that if the dice do not roll our way, we have no chance at blessing or happiness. Scripture tells us, "Give diligence to present thyself approved unto God" (2 Timothy 2:15a, ASV). James tells us that if we look into God's perfect law of liberty and continue in it, we will find blessing. We do not need to hope for blessing, if we continue with God, He will make sure we stay blessed.
