#### The Great Commission

Jesus told his disciples, "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned" (Mark 16:15-16). We call this the great commission. But what makes this commission so great?

First, the one who gave this commission makes it great. Jesus did not walk this earth as merely a man; His resurrection proves that. Nobody but God has the power to walk out of the grave. Second, the message of this commission makes it great. We must take the gospel to the world. Scripture calls this gospel, "the power of God unto salvation" (Romans 1:16). We can find no salvation without Christ (Acts 4:12); therefore, we must hear the gospel, the good news, about Him

Third, the scope of this commission makes it great. Jesus told his disciples to go into the entire world, not just a part of it. God does not want anyone to perish because of sin (2 Peter 3:9), And since He gave the world the gospel to bring about salvation in those that hear it, we must carry that gospel to everyone. Fourth, the result of this commission makes it great. The one who responds to the message of the gospel faithfully and obediently receives salvation. Without salvation, nothing else in the world matters. No accomplishment of man compares to that of obeying the gospel of Christ.

Now we must consider: since God gave us such a great commission, how great an effort should we put into fulfilling it?
