Conduct Unbecoming

The term "conduct unbecoming" is used to describe inappropriate or unethical behavior that goes against a standard of conduct. Although the term is most times recognized in relation to the military, it can be used to describe unacceptable behavior in official civilian or personal settings. When it comes to living the Christian life, the bible does not fall short in warning us about conduct unbecoming a child of God.

In 1 Corinthians 6:9-10 and Galatians 5:19-21, the Apostle Paul lists behaviors that are unbecoming of Christians. As we read these lists, we recognize these as the worst of the worst of personal traits. Even nonreligious folks consider this behavior to be unacceptable. For the Christian to willingly participate in such conduct will cause forfeiture of God's forgiveness and prohibit one from inheriting the kingdom of God. (Heb. 10:26; Gal. 5:21) In a broad sense, worldly behavior is not Christian behavior. If a Christian routinely acts this way, then it is time for repentance and godly sorrow. (2 Cor. 7:10)

We are to be spiritually transformed and separate from the world. (Rom. 12:2) "Therefore, come out from among them and be separate, says the Lord." (2 Cor. 6:17) As a matter of fact, that's exactly what we have done if we have obeyed the gospel message. "And such were some of you. But you were washed, but you were sanctified, but you were justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God." (1 Cor. 6:11) Because God has saved us by His amazing grace, we are to do our best to be holy in all of our conduct. (1 Pet. 1:15)
